Southern Nash FFA Alumni Chapter College/University Scholarship Requirements

The Scholarship Committee of the SNHS Friends, Family & Alumni organization being appointed by the acting President and originally approved by the club on September 15, 2020 does hereby list requirements, accept applications, and award* one \$1,000 for the first year of enrollment to the qualified applicant enrolled as a full-time student in a two or four year college or university degree program. If the applicant is enrolled in a Vocational/Technical/Trade Academic Institution or Program, they can apply for a \$500 scholarship.

Requirements are:

- 1. Applicant must currently be a member of the SNHS FFA Chapter, and has been a member for at least two years.
- 2. Applicant must graduate from high school the year he or she applies for scholarship.
- 3. Applicant must have maintained a 3.0 or above average overall with an 85 or higher average in the CTE courses for the last three years in High School.
- 4. Applicants must have earned their State Degree, and provide a copy of their AET Journal Report and Detailed SAE Report.
- 5. Applicant must be accepted and enrolled at an accredited college or University, a Community College, a Vocational / Technical / Trade Academic Institution or Program.
- 6. All funds will be paid directly to the college or university with a receipt being returned to the alumni chapter secretary/treasurer.
- 7. If in any year there are no applicants who are FFA members, the funds will roll forward to the next school year.
- 8. All applications will be presented to the Committee by March 1, the year of graduation. The committee's recommendation will be presented to the alumni membership for a vote. Committee chair will contact applicant(s) after membership vote. An announcement will be made at the recipient's high school award ceremony.
- 9. In any year, if more than one applicant qualifies, the attached Rubric will be used to determine the successful applicant.
- * Additional scholarships can be awarded in one year at the recommendation of the scholarship committee with the approval of the alumni chapter. Any additional scholarship awards will be an amount determined by the committee and voted on by the alumni chapter.
